NORTH WING WATER HEATER REPLACEMENT

Stratford General Hospital (SGH) has upgraded existing Domestic Hot Water (DHW) equipment with new steam to DHW heat exchangers and controls. The project was completed to improve the controllability of the water temperature and improve energy efficiency.

ENERGY & CARBON SAVINGS

The existing equipment was unable to be controlled in conjunction with onsite Combined Heat and Power (CHP) preheating of DHW. The new heat exchanger equipment improves the controllability of the system and allows for the CHP energy to be used to preheat DHW. This maximizes the overall efficiency of the CHP.
