CHILLER REPLACEMENT

Seaforth Community Hospital (SCH) undertook the replacement of the central water-cooled chiller to achieve improved energy efficiency and reliability. The existing equipment was at end of useful life and the new equipment has greatly improved part-load efficiency to reduce energy consumption at the facility. Further, this project improves hospital infrastructure and ensures reliable cooling for years to come.

ENERGY & CARBON SAVINGS

The new water-cooled chiller provides an increase in overall efficiency through improved compressor and other equipment performance. Further, an upgraded sequence of operation provides more optimal overall chiller plant efficiency. Finally, the existing pumps were also replaced with new equipment and provides variable flow capability for both evaporator and condenser loops which provides significant improvement in pumping and system efficiency.
