LED LIGHTING UPGRADE

Stratford General Hospital (SGH) has begun the process of upgrading their existing lighting within the hospital to LED.

The intent is to improve the lighting conditions throughout the hospital for patients, visitors, and staff. Further, with this improvement to quality, there is also a significant improvement the efficiency of the lighting system.

ENERGY & CARBON SAVINGS

The project provides a significant reduction in overall electricity required for the facility through the replacement of all the light fixtures within the east wing of the hospital.

The improvement per lighting fixture is the range of 40-50% decrease in energy usage.
