Enhanced Quality of Care!

Raising Funds for Hospital Equipment

This year, the Seaforth Community Hospital Foundation is raising funds for several vital pieces of equipment that will strengthen patient care in both the Emergency Department and the Inpatient Unit.

These priorities include an Arjo tub chair, designed to ensure comfort and safety for patients during bathing; a Tornado cleaning system, which disinfects medical equipment to uphold the highest standards of hygiene and infection control; and the ProSim 8 Vital Signs Simulator along with the ProSim Spot SpO2 Pulse Oximeter Tester, which replicate patient vital signs to test and calibrate monitoring equipment with precision which supports accurate, reliable care.

Thanks to your generous support last year, the Foundation was able to fund a Hematology Analyzer, a crucial tool that evaluates blood function and health. This device enables complete blood count (CBC) testing, including red and white blood cell counts, hemoglobin levels, platelet counts, and screening for potential blood disorders.

With your help, we can continue to invest in equipment that supports excellent, compassionate care close to home.
