Terms of Reference

MEMBERSHIP

3-10 Community Representatives (as determined by the Committee)* Chair, Hospital Foundation or designate*

President, Hospital Auxiliary or designate*

1 Director from the Alliance Board who resides in (or near) the community* Site Chief*

Vice-President

1 Municipal Member as determined by sitting Councils in hospital's catchment area

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

The Local Advisory Committee (LAC) shall meet at least quarterly.

MEETING ATTENDANCE

Quorum shall consist of the majority of voting members present at a meeting. Members must attend 75% of meetings to retain membership on the Committee.

RESPONSIBILITIES

To appoint a Chair from the LAC membership, excluding the Board of Directors representative, every two years. Chairs may fulfil more than one two-year term.

Local Advisory Committees have three primary purposes:

- to provide input and education to the Alliance board on issues of importance to the community served by the Hospital, including:
 - providing advice and consultation in the development of the Alliance's mission, vision and values;
 - providing advice and consultation in the development of the Alliance's strategic plan;
 - providing advice and consultation on any Alliance board decision to add or eliminate services and programs at the local Hospital facility;
 - providing advice and consultation on local community health and wellness issues:
 - providing advice and consultation on strategies for recruiting and retaining Professional Staff resources in the local community;
 - providing ad hoc recommendations as to whether it is in the Hospital's best interest
 to withdraw from the Alliance, provided that a recommendation that a Hospital
 withdraw from the Alliance can be made to the Alliance board a maximum of once
 every two (2) years per local advisory committee;
 - attending the annual strategic planning advances with the Alliance board;

- working with the Alliance board to organize information sessions held by the Alliance for the local community; and
- at the request of the Alliance board, assisting with the coordination of efforts in the local community among the Alliance and the local Hospital's auxiliary and foundation.
- ii. to approve the disposition by the Alliance board of any Real Property that was owned by the Hospital on the Effective Date; and
- iii. to serve as a training ground for future Alliance board members. To that end, the Governance & Stakeholders Relations Committee shall encourage each Local Advisory Committee to nominate candidates whenever a vacancy on the Alliance board in the local advisory committee's community arises, and the Governance & Stakeholder Relations Committee shall give particular consideration to such candidates.

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
